

ORDINANCE NO. XVI

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE CREATION AND MAINTENANCE OF A
TOWN COUNTY HEALTH DEPARTMENT IN WENDOVER TOWN

Be it ordained by the Wendover Town Council that pursuant to Title 26, Chapter 15, Section 34 U.C.A. 1953 as amended; providing that cities and Counties in the State may cooperate and consolidate in the formation and creation of the Board of Health,

AND WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Tooele County has adopted an ordinance providing for the consolidation of Town-County health Departments.

AND WHEREAS, the Town Council of Wendover Town, State of Utah, by its duly elected legislative body is of the opinion that all health matters, rules and regulations of said town may best be carried out and expedited by consolidation of the Town-County Health Department, which said health Department now has a complete, adequate and functioning staff of competent personnel,

AND WHEREAS, it is the desire of the legislative body of said Wendover Town that the best health service possible be rendered to its inhabitants and citizens.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE WENDOVER TOWN COUNCIL that the matters of local health rules, regulations and procedures be and the same are hereby vested in the Town-County Health Department. That by this Ordinance the Town herein designated does vest in said Town-County Health Department all and every power to act in said Town and in the enforcement of all health rules and regulations and in the administration of all public health matters as effectively as though said health rules were administered by said Town, and said Town-County Health department and all of its personnel shall have complete jurisdiction to act within said Town within the lawful capacity of said personnel.



AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE JOINING OF THE
TOWN OF WENDOVER WITH TOOELE COUNTY
IN THE CREATION OF A FULL TIME
CITY-COUNTY HEALTH DEPARTMENT



The Town Board of Wendover ordains as follows:

WHEREAS, Tooele County, a body politic, has heretofore adopted an ordinance creating a full time city-county health department in accordance with the Public Health Code of the State of Utah, and providing that the maintenance of said department shall be financed by a general county levy upon all the property in the county and in the cities and towns of the county; and

WHEREAS, this body feels that it will be to the advantage, benefit and best interests of this Town and to the citizens thereof that the professional personnel and the facilities of the Health Department be operative in and have jurisdiction and provide protection in this Town;

SECTION I. That the Town of Wendover hereby joins with Tooele County and the other participating towns and cities of Tooele County in the creation of a full time city-county health department in Tooele County, State of Utah.

SECTION II. That the city-county health department so created and known as "Tooele County Health Department" is hereby authorized and empowered to act within the incorporated limits of the Town of Wendover in accordance with authority granted to a city-county health department in Title 26, Chapter 15, Sections 33 to 53 inclusive, of U. C. A. 1953, as amended.

SECTION III. That it is necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the Town and the inhabitants thereof that this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage and upon the date of its first publication in accordance with law.

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE CREATION AND
MAINTENANCE OF A CITY-COUNTY HEALTH DEPARTMENT
IN THE TOWN OF WENDOVER, STATE OF UTAH

The Town Council of the Town of Wendover of the County of Tooele
ordains as follows:

WHEREAS, Title 26, Chapter 15, Section 34, entitled "Local Full-
Time Health Department" provides that cities and towns of any county
in this State may cooperate and consolidate with any such county in the
formation and creation of the Board of Health.

AND WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Tooele County,
State of Utah, have adopted an Ordinance #61- providing for the creation
and maintenance of a City-County Health Department in the Town of Wendover
State of Utah.

AND WHEREAS, Town of Wendover of Tooele County, State of Utah
by its duly elected legislative body is of the opinion that all health
matters rules and regulations of said Town may best be carried out and
expedited by consolidation of the present County Health Department, which
said Health Department now has a complete, adequate and functioning staff
of competent personnel, and the present Board of Health of the Town of
Wendover.

AND WHEREAS, it is the desire of the legislative body of said Town
of Wendover that the best health service possible be rendered by its
inhabitants and citizens.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF
Wendover that the matters of local health rules, regulations and procedures
be and the same are hereby vested in the Town County Health Department.
That by this ordinance the Town herein designated does vest in said Town
County Health Department all and every power to act in said Town in the
enforcement of all health rules and regulations and in the administration
of all public health matters as effectively as though said health rules

were administered by said Town, and said Town County Health Department and all of its personnel shall have complete jurisdiction to act within said Town within the lawful capacity of said personnel.

This ordinance shall take effect 30 days after its passage or 20 days after its publication, whichever date is later.
