

ODINANCE NO. 78- 6

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE CREATION OF  
A MEDICAL BOARD FOR THE TOWN OF WENDOVER , UTAH

WHEREAS, the Town of Wendover, Utah has undertaken for the health , safety and welfare of its inhabitants an Ambulance Service; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees and the Town President have determined it to be in the best interest and for the health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the Town of Wendover, Utah that a Town Medical Board be established to administer the Town Clinic and Ambulance Service.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby ordained by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Wendover, Utah as follows:

Section 1: TOWN MEDICAL BOARD. There is hereby created a Medical Board to be known as "The Medical Board of the Town of Wendover, Utah".

Section 2: TERMS OF OFFICE. The governing body of the Medical Board shall be composed of ten (10) members appointed on a non-partisan basis by the Board of Trustees and Town President of the Town of Wendover, Utah, to consist of three (3) members from minority ethnic groups; two (2) members who are residents of the unincorporated Town of West Wendover, Nevada and not more than six (6) of the members being of the same sex.

The members appointed to the Medical Board at the time the Board is originally organized shall determine by lot the length of term to be served by each member so that preferably the term of one member shall expire each year, but in any case so that the terms of a majority of the members of the Board shall not expire in any one (1) year. The term of office of members first appointed shall not exceed four (4) years. Theafter, full term appointments shall be for four (4) years. Members appointed to fill vacancies shall hold office until expiration of the terms of their predecessors.

Section 3: MEDICAL BOARD OFFICERS. The Medical board shall, at its organization meeting, elect from its members a president and such other officers as it shall determine. All officers shall hold office at the pleasure of the Board.

Section 4. AUTHORITY. The Meical Board shall have authority to administer the Wendover Ambulance Service and Wendover Clinic.

Section 5. BUDGET. The Medical Board shall submit a proposed budget on or before the first day of April of each year to the Board of Trustees of the Town of Wendover, Utah for approval of said budget by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Wendover, Utah.

Section 6. PERSONNEL. All personnel necessary for the successful operation fo the Wendover Ambulance Service and

Wendover Clinic Service shall be hired and/or dismissed with cause by the Medical Board with the approval of the Board of Trustees of the Town of Wendover, Utah.

Section 7. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall be effective thirty (30) days after the date of its passage and after having been posted in three public places in the Town of Wendover, Tooele County, State of Utah, for a period of not less than 20 days.
