

An Ordinance providing for the creation of a Board to Administer the Wendover Air Force Base Properties(Decker Field)

WHEREAS; The Town of Wendover has acquired certain properties known as the Wendover Air Force Base and also known as Decker Field, and

WHEREAS; The Board of Trustees of the Town of Wendover have determined that the best interest of the Town of Wendover will be served by the creation of a Board to administer the aforesaid properties.

NOW THEREFORE; it is hereby ordained by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Wendover, Utah as follows:

SECTION 1: There is hereby created a Board to administer the Wendover Air Force Base Properties to be known as "The Decker Field Administrative Authority."

SECTION 2: COMPOSITION: The Decker Field Administrative Authority shall be composed of a Chairperson and four (4) other members who shall be appointed by the Town President by and with the consent of the Board of Trustees of the Town of Wendover, Utah.

SECTION 3: TERMS OF OFFICE: The term of appointment for the members first appointed shall be as follows; The term of office of the Chairperson and of 2 members shall be from the date of appointment until January 31, 1983 and the term of office of the other 2 members shall be from the date of appointment until January 31, 1981
THEREAFTER the term of appointments shall be for four(4) years.

SECTION 4: MEETINGS. Meetings of the Decker Field Administrative Authority shall be called by the Chairperson who shall give each member at least five(5) days notice of the time and place of the meeting, however, at least one meeting shall be held in each three(3) month period.

SECTION 5: DUTIES: The Decker Field Administrative Authority shall administer Decker Field in accordance with the terms of the "Quit Claim" Deed granting the Field to the Town of Wendover. It shall negotiate leases to the various properties of the Field and shall determine the terms and conditions of the said leases. The Chairperson of the Decker Field Administrative Authority shall make a quarterly report to the Board of Trustees of the Town of Wendover of the business conducted by the Authority.

SECTION 6: EFFECTIVE DATE: This ordinance shall be effective


Thirty(30) days after the date of its passage and after having been posted in three public places in the Town of Wendover, Tooele County, State of Utah, for a period of not less than 20 days.


