

ORDINANCE NO. 82-7

AN ORDINANCE APPOINTING A TOWN MARSHALL;
DETERMINING COMPENSATION AND DUTIES AND
RESPONSIBILITIES.

WHEREAS, the Wendover Town Council has deemed it necessary in order to enforce local laws and regulations and to protect the peace and tranquility of the community, to appoint a Town Marshall.

WHEREAS, the Mayor of the Town of Wendover, with the consent of the governing body, shall forthwith appoint or fill any vacancy by appointment according to the Utah law.

WHEREAS, the powers and duties of the Town Marshall, or any of his deputies, shall be those stated in Section 10-3-913 thru Section 10-3-915, U.C.A., 1953, as amended, and more particularly described as follows:

1) He shall have the same powers and responsibilities as sheriffs and constables, he shall suppress riots, disturbances and breaches of the peace, and apprehend all persons committing any offense against the laws of the State or ordinances of the Town.

2) He shall, at all times, diligently and faithfully discharge his duties and enforce all ordinances and regulations of the Town for the preservation of peace, good order and the protection of the rights and property of all persons.

3) He shall prevent crime, detect and arrest offenders, remove nuisances existing in the public streets, roads, and highways and perform all duties required of him by ordinance or resolution.
