

ORDINANCE NO. 82-8

AN ORDINANCE APPOINTING A TOWN JUSTICE OF THE PEACE; DETERMINING COMPENSATION; PAYMENT OF FEES, FINES, FORFEITURES OR OTHER SUMS TO TREASURER.

WHEREAS, the Wendover Town Council has deemed it necessary in order to enforce local laws and regulations and to protect the peace and tranquility of the community, to appoint a Town Justice of the Peace.

WHEREAS, the Justice of the Peace shall be appointed for a four (4) year term, beginning on the first Monday in February, 1980. That the Town Justice of the Peace may be removed from office in the same manner as County Justices.

WHEREAS, the Mayor of the Town of Wendover, with the consent of the governing body, shall forthwith fill any vacancy by appointment for the unexpired term, pursuant to Section 10-3-923, U.C.A., 1953, as amended.

WHEREAS, the salary of the Town Justice of the Peace shall be set by ordinance in the manner prescribed by Section 78-5-29, U.C.A., 1953, as amended.

WHEREAS, all fees, fines, forfeitures or any other sums collected by the Justice of the Peace shall be paid to the Town treasurer within seven (7) days of receipt.
