

ORDINANCE NO. 82-10


AN ORDINANCE DECLARING THE OFFICIAL NAME OF WENDOVER, UTAH.

WHEREAS, THE HONORABLE SCOTT MATHESON, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF UTAH, HAS DECLARED THAT THE TOWN OF WENDOVER HAS MET THE REQUIREMENTS TO BECOME A THIRD CLASS CITY WITHIN THE STATE OF UTAH;

WHEREAS, AN OFFICIAL STATE OF UTAH PROCLAMATION HAS BEEN ISSUED PROCLAIMING THE TOWN OF WENDOVER A THIRD CLASS CITY;

THEREFORE; THE TOWN OF WENDOVER SHALL HENCE FORTH BE KNOWN AS THE CITY OF WENDOVER AND THE WENDOVER TOWN BOARD SHALL HENCE FORTH BE KNOWN AS THE WENDOVER CITY COUNCIL.


AMENDMENT TO CHAPTER FIVE (5), BOARD OF
ADJUSTMENT, CITY OF WENDOVER ZONING
ORDINANCE.

AMENDMENT TO 5-12.

That the ordinance entitled Board of Adjustment, Chapter 5,
Section 12, shall be amended to read as follows:


"Compensation of Members and Secretary. The members of the
Board of Adjustment shall serve without compensation. The
secretary for the Board of Adjustment shall be compensated at
the rate of \$6.00 per hour. That the secretary shall attend
each Board meeting and write a summary of each meeting, which
shall be kept with the Recorder. This report is due within
seven (7) days after any Board meeting."

5-11. Filing Fee. Upon filing of any appeal or application to the Board of Adjustment, the appellant or applicant shall pay to the City a fee prescribed by the City Council. The said fee shall be collected by the officer in whose office said appeal is filed and shall be deposited with the City Recorder and credited to the general fund. No appeal or application shall be considered by the Board of Adjustment unless and until such fee has been paid.

Change 5-12. Compensation of Members and Secretary. Each member of the Board of Adjustment and the Secretary thereof shall be compensated by an amount established by the City Council for each meeting of the Board which he shall attend.
