MUNICIPAL ELECTION ORDINANCE


AN ORDINANCE PURSUANT TO HOUSE BILL 263 ELECTING THAT THE CITY OF WENDOVER, UTAH EXEMPT ITSELF FROM PRIMARY ELECTIONS FOR THE MUNICIPALITY.

WHEREAS, the City Council for the City of Wendover has deemed it reasonable and prudent and in the best interests of the public to formulate an ordinance exempting the City of Wendover from having to conduct primary elections in the City of Wendover.

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, that pursuant to 20-5-11(1), Utah Code Annotated, as amended, it is hereby ordained that the City of Wendover shall exempt itself from conducting primary elections in the municipality, and furthermore, that nominations of candidates for municipal office shall be conducted at conventions or nominating committees.

This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon posting it in three (3) public places within the City of Wendover, Utah.
