

ORDINANCE NO. 85-1

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE DISCHARGE  
OF FIREARMS WITHIN THE WENDOVER CITY LIMITS

Whereas, the Wendover City Council has deemed it reasonable and prudent in order to promote the public's safety and welfare to prohibit the discharge of any firearm within the Wendover City limits, with some exceptions.

Whereas, the discharge of firearms within the Wendover City limits shall not be unlawful if it is done at specifically designated rifle ranges.

The term "fire arm" is defined as follows:

"Any pistol, revolvers, sawed off shotguns, or sawed off rifles, and/or any device that could be used as a weapon from which is expelled a projectile by any force."

76-10-501 Utah Code Annotated.

That violation of this ordinance shall be a Class "A" misdemeanor.


This ordinance repeals any other previous ordinance concerning discharging of firearms within the City limits.

That this ordinance shall become effective thirty (30) days after posting in three (3) public places.
