An Ordinance establishing rules and procedures for the upcoming 1985 Municipal Elections according to the laws of the State of Utah.


Wherefore, it has been deemed reasonable and prudent by the Wendover City Council that in order to properly conduct the 1985 Municipal Elections of the City of Wendover, Utah, that the following rules and procedures are hereby mandated:

1. That there shall be no primary elections in the City of Wendover for the 1985 elections.
2. That those persons who desire to be nominated for public office must be nominated either by a designated political party or committee as outlined in \_\_\_\_\_, Utah Code Annotated, 1953.
3. That the General Election for municipal offices in the City of Wendover shall be Partisan 1985.
4. That this ordinance was passed by unanimous vote of the Wendover City Council on May 21, 1985, and was made effective that date.
