

ORDINANCE NO.94-05

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING PENALTIES FOR DAMAGING STREET SIGNS AND THE PLACING OF HOUSE STREET NUMBERS ON RESIDENCES IN WENDOVER, UTAH.

WHEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, that the Wendover City Council has deemed it reasonable and prudent in order to promote health and safety of its citizens to make the following conduct mandatory:


1. That every house in Wendover City shall have an identifying street number after the 31st day of MARCH 1994;
2. That identifying street signs shall be posted at appropriate locations; and
3. That any person found to be in violation of not having an appropriate indentifying house number after the 31st day of MARCH, 1994, shall be guilty of a Class B Misdemeanor.
4. That any person found damaging, destroying or interfering with any street sign shall be guilty of a Class B Misdemeanor.

That this ordinance shall become effective thirty(30) days after passage and legal posting.
