AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING A FINAL BUDGET; MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE SUPPORT OF WENDOVER CITY FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JULY 1, 1994, AND ENDING JUNE 30, 1995; AND DETERMINING THE RATE OF TAX AND LEVYING TAXES UPON ALL REAL AND PERSONAL PROPERTY WITHIN WENDOVER CITY, UTAH; MADE TAXABLE BY LAW FOR THE YEAR 1994.

WHEREAS, the Mayor of Wendover City, as required by law, submitted to the Wendover City Council a budget for the fiscal year commencing July 1, 1994 and ending June 30, 1995; and

WHEREAS, the Budget was carefully reviewed, considered, revised and adopted by the City Council; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to law, a copy of the Budget was placed on record at the City Recorder's Office at the address indicated below, for inspection by the general public during normal office hours; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to law, a public hearing to receive public comment and consider adoption of a final budget (herein the "Budget") was held on June 21, 1994, at 5:00 p.m., in the City Council Chambers located at 195 South First Street, Wendover City, Utah ; and

WHEREAS, the date, time and place of the hearing, the right of citizens to be heard, the summary of the Budget and the location of the City Recorder's Office where the Budget was available for public inspection were posted in the City Offices, Post Office, and Fred's Market, within Tooele County at least seven days prior to said hearing; and

WHEREAS, citizens in attendance at the public hearing were permitted to provide written or oral comment for or against the Budget; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to law, the City Council of Wendover City, at a regularly scheduled meeting of the City Council, must adopt the property tax rate and set the property tax levy before the 22nd day of June of each year; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to law, the City has posted the necessary notice and held the public hearings required prior to adopting the

proposed property tax rate and setting the property tax levy; and

WHEREAS, it is the intent and desire of Wendover City to comply with all applicable State and local laws regarding the adoption of the Budget, the adoption of a property tax rate and the levy of property taxes; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that it is in the best interests of the citizens of Wendover City to adopt a final budget for Wendover City and determine the rate of tax and levy taxes upon all real and personal property within Wendover City;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of Wendover City, State of Utah, as follows:

**Section 1. Budget Adoption.**

A. The amounts shown in Exhibit "A", attached hereto and by this reference incorporated herein, are hereby appropriated for the corporate purposes and objects of Wendover City, Utah for the fiscal year commencing July 1, 1994 and ending June 30, 1995, and are hereby adopted as the Budget of Wendover City, Utah for the fiscal year 1994-1995.

B. Pursuant to law, a copy of the Budget for each fund within the Budget shall be certified by the Budget Officer and shall be filed with the State Auditor within 30 days after adoption of the Budget.

C. Pursuant to law, a certified copy of the Budget shall be filed in the office of the City Recorder and shall be available for public inspection during regular business hours.

**Section 2. Tax Rate and Levy.**

A. For the purpose of defraying the necessary and proper expenses of Wendover City and for maintaining the government thereof, it is hereby determined that the rate of the general Wendover City property tax to be levied against all real and personal property within Wendover City made taxable by law for the Year 1994 is hereby set at a rate not to exceed the certified rate to be determined by Tooele County.

B. There is hereby levied upon all real and personal property within Wendover City made taxable by law in the Year 1994, for the fiscal year of Wendover City ending June 30, 1995, the tax rate as set forth above, on the taxable value of said property, to provide revenue for the Wendover City General Fund and for general City purposes.

C. As required by law, the rate hereinabove determined and levied, along with all statements and information required by law, shall be reported to the Auditor of Tooele County, State of Utah, and the Utah State Tax Commission.

**Section 3. Further Action.** In addition to the foregoing, the Mayor is hereby directed to implement any other necessary actions pertinent to the adoption of the Budget, the establishment of a tax rate and the levy of property taxes. Such actions may include, but are not necessarily limited to, notification, reporting and publishing as required by and consistent with applicable law.

**Section 4. Severability.** If any provision of this Ordinance is declared invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder shall not be affected thereby.

**Section 5. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall take effect upon passage and posting.
