

ORDINANCE NO. 97-02

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING LEGAL HOLIDAYS IN THE CITY OF WENDOVER, TOOELE COUNTY, UTAH, AND SETTING THE DATES THEREOF DURING THE CALENDAR YEAR 1997.

RECITALS

1. The City of Wendover is authorized to declare legal holidays within the City and to give notice of the same; and

2. The City deems it necessary and appropriate to give notice of holidays during the calendar year 1997.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE WENDOVER CITY COUNCIL:

Section No. 1. Ordinance Enacted. There is hereby enacted an Ordinance, consistent with the law of the State of Utah, setting the dates of holidays within the City.

Section No. 2. Dates of Holidays. All legal holidays established by Utah Code Annotated Section 63-13-2, or any successor statute, shall be legal holidays in the City.

A. The following named days are legal holidays within the City of Wendover, Tooele County, Utah:

Description	Date	Date in 1997
New Years Day	January 1	January 1
Human Rights Day	the third Monday of January	January 20
Presidents Day	the third Monday of February	February 17
Memorial Day	the last Monday of May	May 26
Independence Day	July 4	July 4
Pioneer Day	July 24	July 24
Labor Day	the first Monday of September	September 1
Columbus Day	the second Monday of October	October 24
Veterans' Day	November 11	November 11
Thanksgiving Day	the fourth Thursday of November	November 27
Christmas	December 25	December 25

B. If any of the holidays described in Section 2.A., above, falls on a Sunday, then the following Monday shall be the holiday. If any of the holidays described in Section 2.A., above, falls on a Saturday, then the preceding Friday shall be the holiday.


Section 3. Additional Holidays. Whenever in its opinion extraordinary circumstances exist justifying the action, the City Council may declare by resolution legal holidays in addition to those identified in Section 2, above.

Section No. 4. Repealer. All other ordinances and regulations previously adopted by the City and relating to the subject matter of this Ordinance are repealed as of the effective date of this Ordinance.

Section No. 5. Severability Clause. The provisions of this Ordinance and all regulations thereunder, are severable. If any provision of this Ordinance is held invalid or unenforceable for any reason, said invalidity or unenforceability shall not affect any other provision of this Ordinance or its application under a different circumstance.

Section No. 6. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective twenty (20) days after publication or posting or thirty (30) days after final passage by the governing body, whichever is sooner.
