

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING LEGAL HOLIDAYS IN THE CITY OF WENDOVER, TOOELE COUNTY, UTAH, AND SETTING THE DATES THEREOF DURING THE CALENDAR YEAR 1998.

RĒCITALS

1. The City of Wendover is authorized to declare legal holidays within the City and to give notice of the same; and

2. The City deems it necessary and appropriate to give notice of holidays during the calendar year 1998.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE WENDOVER CITY COUNCIL:


Section NO. 1. Ordinance Enacted. There is hereby enacted an Ordinance, consistent with the law of the State of Utah, setting the dates of holidays within the City.

Section NO. 2. Dates of Holidays. All legal holidays established by Utah Code Annotated Section 63-13-2, or any successor statute, shall be legal holidays in the City.

A. The following named days are legal holidays within the City of Wendover, Tooele County, Utah:

New Years Day	January 1	January 1, 1998
Human Rights Day	The third Monday of January	January 19, 1998
Presidents Day	The third Monday of February	February 16, 1998
Memorial Day	The last Monday of May	May 25, 1998
Independence Day	July 4	July 4, 1998
Pioneer Day	July 24	July 24, 1998
Labor Day	The first Monday of September	September 7, 1998
Columbus Day	The second Monday of October	October 12, 1998
Veteran's Day	November 11	November 11, 1998
Thanksgiving Day	The fourth Thursday of November	November 26, 1998
Christman Day	December 25	December 25, 1998
