

ORDINANCE NO. 2003 – 02

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A SEWER
RATE FOR SEWER SERVICES TO ENTITIES
LOCATED IN THE STATE OF NEVADA WHICH DO
NOT UTILIZE AND PAY FOR THE CITY'S WATER SERVICE

RECITALS

- A. The City of Wendover, Tooele County, Utah owns and operates a sewer system serving businesses and residences within the City and in the State of Nevada.
- B. The City owns and operates a culinary water system serving businesses and residences within the City.
- C. Until recently, the City's water system has provided services to a business entity in Nevada.
- D. The City has developed its public works department budget with the assumption that all users of the city's public utilities (water and sewer) would be connected to, utilize and pay for both services.
- E. The City's budgetary requirements are such that the Governing Body has determined that it is reasonable and necessary to increase sewer rates charged to any user or entity, located in the State of Nevada, which utilizes the City's sewer system, but does not utilize the City's water system.
- F. The City is authorized by law to establish regulations and to exercise administrative powers, including the imposition of rates for sewer service, by the adoption and implementation of ordinances and resolutions.

RESOLUTION

BE IT ORDAINED as follows:

1. The City's rates for sewer services to entities and users in the State of Nevada, which are not connected to and utilizing the City's water system, shall be equal to the rates charged by the City of West Wendover, Nevada.

2. The City's rates for sewer services to entities and users located in the State of Nevada, who are not connected to and utilizing the City's water system, shall be as follows:

A. Two Dollars and Twenty-five cents (\$2.25) per each thousand gallons of water used by such entities, which flows into the City's sewer system; and

B. A minimum charge of \$18.50 per month if less than the above referenced increment of water is used by such entities, and flows into the City's water system.


The above rates shall remain in effect until otherwise altered by ordinance or resolution.

3. Any user of the City's sewer services shall provide complete and accurate reports to the City of its water usage so as to enable a calculation of sewer charges. Said reports shall be provided to the City no later than the fifth (5th) day of the month for each preceding month.

4. If any user of the City's sewer services, as described herein, fails to report its water use within the time stated above, or fails to pay its sewer fees in full within thirty (30) days of a billing date, the City shall be authorized and empowered to terminate sewer service to said user, upon forth-eight (48) hours written notice.


5. This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon passage by the Governing Body and posting in three (3) public places in the City.
