

ORDINANCE NO. 2006 - 04

**AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING TEMPORARY RESTRICTIONS
OF OFF PREMISE OUTDOOR ADVERTISING SIGNS IN THE
CITY OF WENDOVER, UTAH**

RECITALS

A. The City adopted Ordinance no. 2006-02 on February 1, 2006 and said ordinance became effective on the date of posting, March 22, 2006.

B. Said ordinance provides for a temporary moratorium on off premise outdoor advertising signs within the City.

C. The City desires to extend said moratorium through six months from the effective date thereof.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF WENDOVER,
UTAH AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Moratorium Extended. The effective date of Ordinance no. 2006-02 shall continue through September 22, 2006, which date is six months after the date said ordinance was posted as required by law. All other provisions of Ordinance no. 2006-02 shall remain in full force and effect through September 22, 2006.


Section 2. Severability. The provisions of this Ordinance are severable. If any provision of this Ordinance is held invalid or unenforceable for any reason, said invalidity or unenforcability shall not affect any other provision of this Ordinance or its application under a different circumstance.


